Executive Summary

Mr. Andersen's career has spanned over 40 years and includes building one of the largest full service accounting firms in the North Bay. Over the last 30 years Mr. Andersen's focus shifted from his extensive tax background to business valuation, financial consulting, and the forensic consulting arena. He is a nationally recognized leader in business valuation and has utilized his valuation skill sets to work with the legal community on a regular basis in areas of complex partnership, corporate, and dissenting shareholder actions as well as economic damage and other forensic accounting assignments. Mr. Andersen also has worked in the family law arena dealing specifically with high net worth cases that involve the valuation of a business as part of the community estate. He has provided testimony on a variety of forensic assignments throughout California.

On the financial consulting side, Mr. Andersen has performed hundreds of valuations for mergers and acquisitions, estate and gift matters, and buy/sell agreements. He acts as a financial facilitator for numerous companies and assists businesses in a broad spectrum of industries and professions in business succession planning and exit strategies. Mr. Andersen's professional experience has also included being an active board member for a significant Bay Area company as well as acting as a provisional director for multiple companies during a shareholder dispute action.

Teaching, writing and public speaking are passions of Mr. Andersen. He has been an instructor at the national level for the American Institute of CPAs and speaks frequently at many of their annual valuation and forensic accounting symposiums. Mr. Andersen has written four courses for the California Society of Certified Public Accountants: a six day extensive business valuation curriculum, mergers and acquisitions for mid-market companies, business succession planning and exit strategies, and opportunities and methodologies for running a successful litigation practice.

He is currently on the Forensic Services Section Steering Committee of the California Society of CPAs, is a past chairman for the business valuation section of the forensic services section of the California Society of CPAs, and has chaired numerous conferences for both the American Institute of CPAs as well as the California Society of CPAs.

Mr. Andersen graduated with a degree in accounting from California State University in Chico and has a Masters Degree in Taxation from Golden Gate University in San Francisco.
